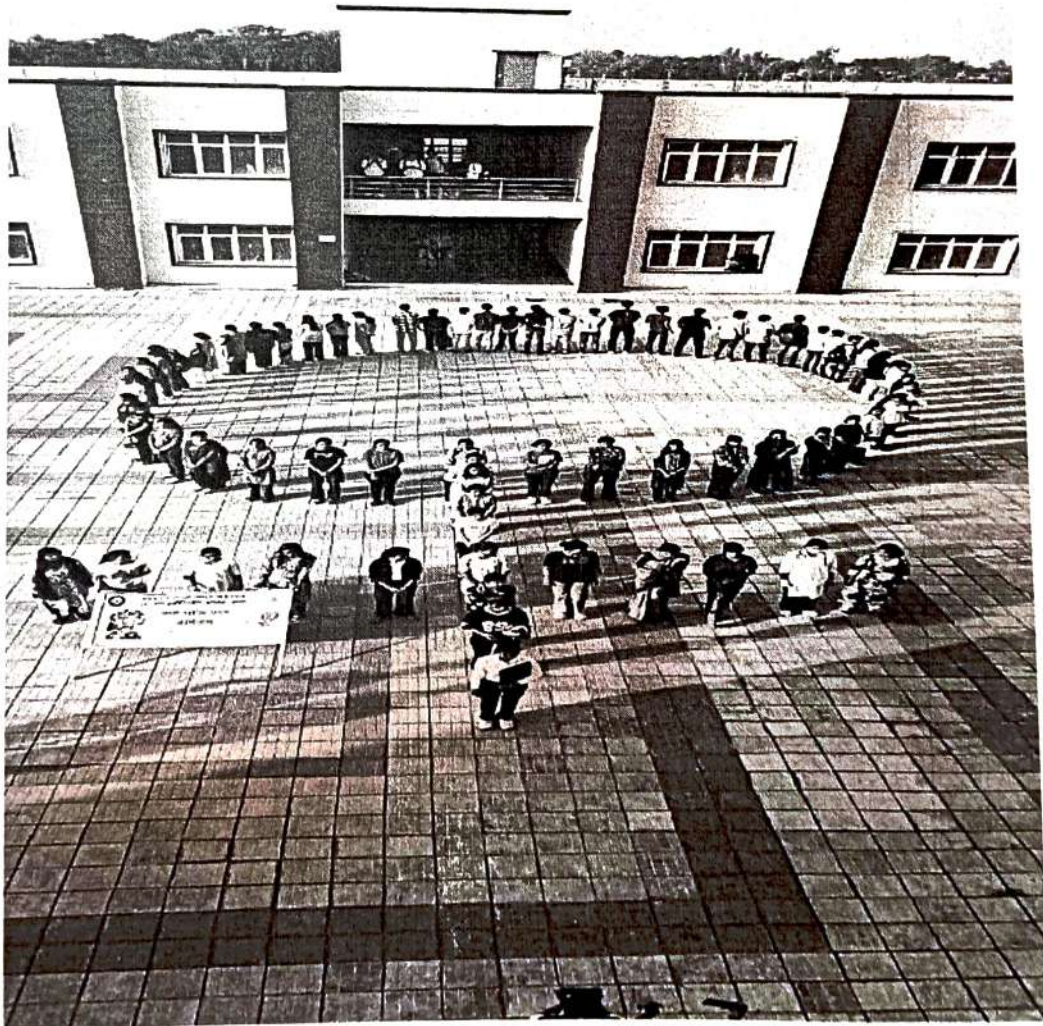

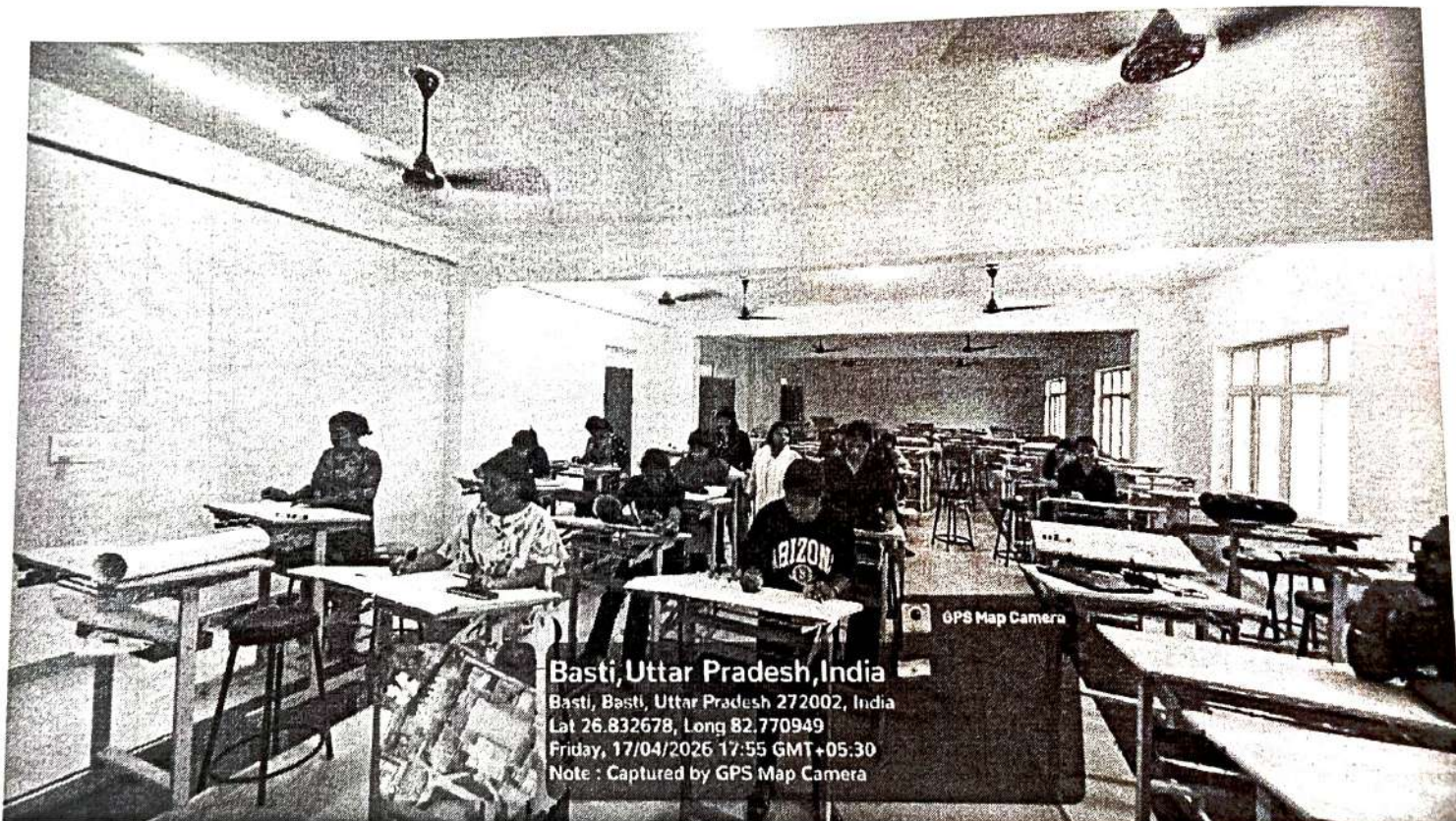

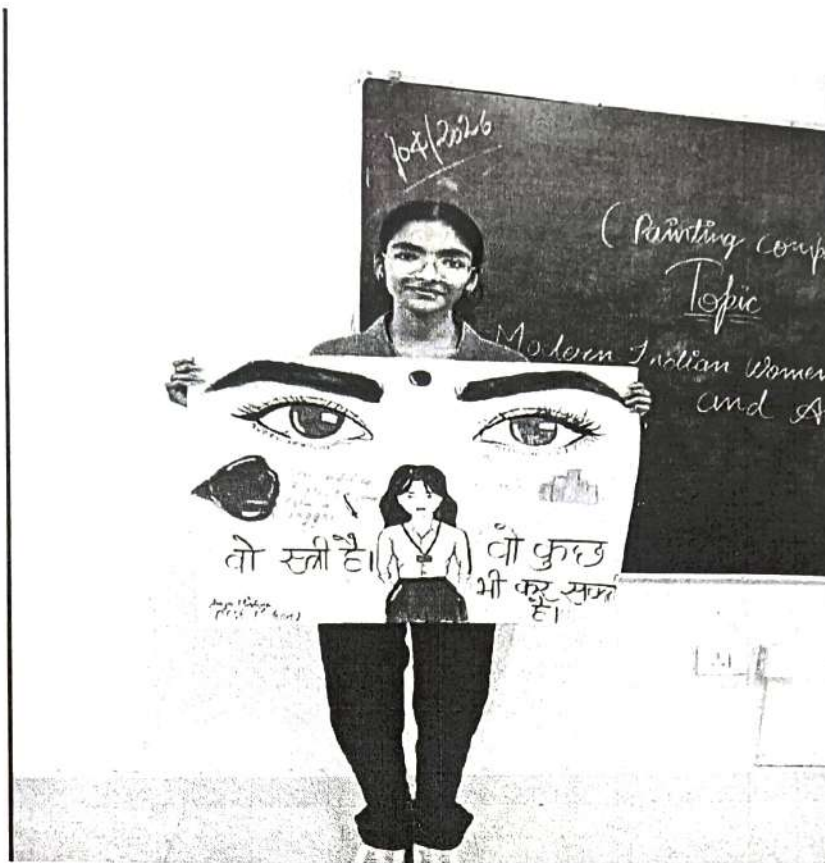
The rally covered key areas from the college campus to Polytechnic Chauraha, drawing attention from the local community and successfully conveying the message of social responsibility and awareness.

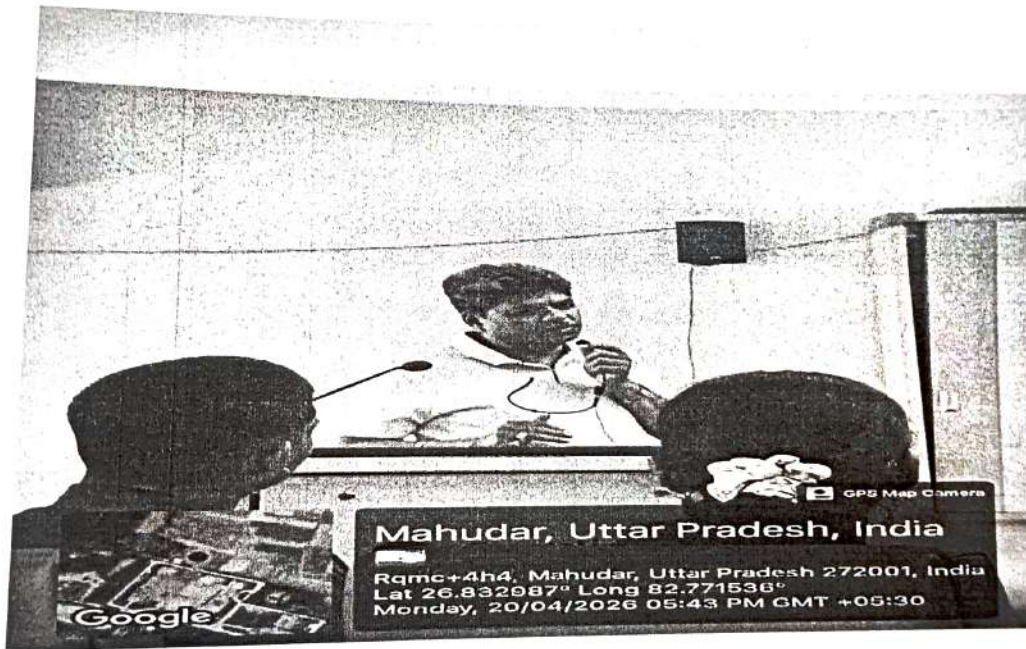


